

Information for the Installer – SmartBrake

This document helps you find the correct information when installing, testing and handing over SmartBrake.

Important before handover

SmartBrake must be installed according to the agreed solution, quotation and the cyclist's needs.

Before the bicycle is handed over, the complete installation should be assessed. The solution must be suitable for the bicycle and the intended user.

If SmartBrake is intended for both the cyclist and an accompanying person, both should have access to a suitable way of braking the bicycle in accordance with the agreed setup.

In most cases, the cyclist should still be able to operate a brake independently, unless another solution has been specifically agreed upon and assessed as appropriate for the user.

Functional test

SmartBrake should be tested after installation and before the bicycle is handed over to the customer.

Check that the brake activates as expected, that all controllers work correctly and that the braking response is clear and consistent.

Test the system while stationary first, and then at low speed in a safe area.

Also check that the hoses, cables, SmartBrake unit and controllers are securely installed and do not interfere with the wheels, steering, pedals, chain or other moving parts.
